Forum Presenters

Pauline Grogan – Pauline’s life has had many twists and turns. The experiences of 12 years as a Catholic teaching nun and 23 years of Marriage (with 4 children in 3 years and 9 months) led her to ask the question, “Who Am I When No One Sees?” At 50, after being involved in the lives of families whose children had had a stroke, Pauline studied for her first degree researching the “Impact of Trauma on Siblings.” Twelve years ago Pauline left her marriage and began to stand alone. In 2005, in her 60th year, she took to the stage for the first time when her life story premiered as a One Woman Theatre Play "500 Letters". She is an inspirational speaker and author whose life changing presentations engage, entertain and challenge. She creates a memorable experience that has inspired audiences nationwide. Pauline recounts true-life stories with humour and humility; she explores the universal themes of challenge, change and triumph. She leaves her audiences in no doubt that the hardships of life are often the very opportunities we need to awaken unknown possibilities within ourselves. Pauline’s insights and inspirations find application in any sphere of life where opportunities wait to be discovered.

Ross McPherson – Ross is the Deputy Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages, a business unit of Identity Services, Department of Internal Affairs. He was appointed as the Deputy Registrar-General in August 2005. Prior to that he was a Manager at the Commerce Commission for 9 years and prior to that an Investigator at the Commission.
